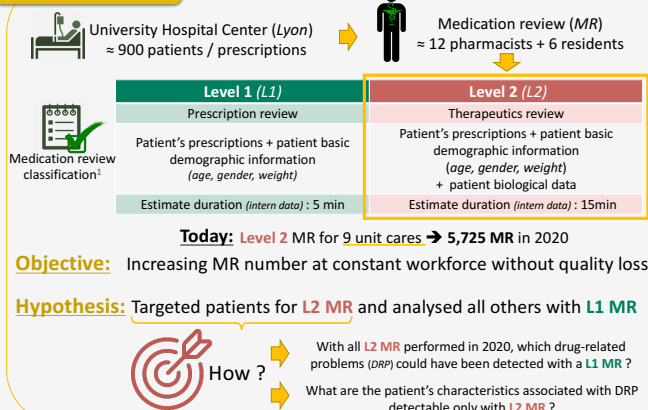
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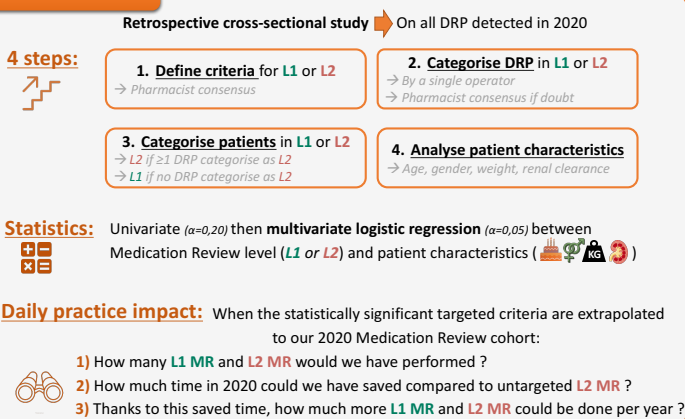
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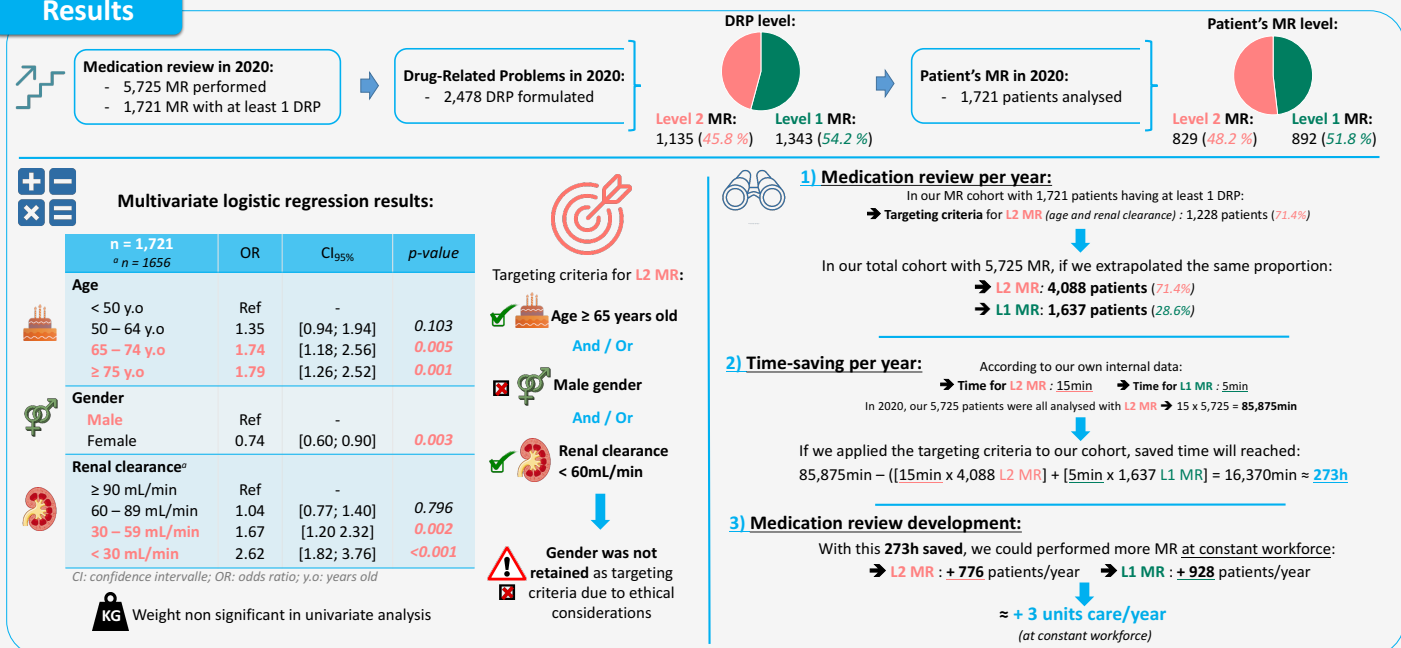

In this study, to extend pharmacist-led medication review at constant workforce, targeting patients for level 2 analysis (more complete but more time-consuming) will allow us to develop this activity in 3 more units care per year.



Targeting criteria retained are:

- Age ≥ 65 years old
- Renal clearance < 60mL/min



Original targeting approach:

- Based on our current practice → Retrospective study
- Maintaining the same level of quality → Targeted L2 MR
- While increasing our MR capacity → Develop L1 MR



To go further:

- Adapted professional software to extract targeted patients
- Re-evaluate and adapt targeting criteria at distance
